Language, Literacy and Communication

We shall join in with repeated phrases and anticipate key events in stories.

We will be building on skills to care for books. This will increase the range of books we read. We will move on to following a story without cues.

We shall understand how and why questions. They will also break speech in to words. The children will move on to writing short sentences.

We will be following 2 step instructions.

Personal and Social Emotional Development

We will build on skills to play cooperatively with others.

We shall listen to ideas from others

This will lead on to speaking confidently in groups.

Creative Development

We shall look at the artist Seurat and building skills for making enclosures

The children will tap out rhythm with noises from a car journey

We shall act out narratives. This will lead on to them building stories for characters in narrative play

Physical Development
