

Language, Literacy and Communication

The children will be developing their communication skills sharing information and speaking in full sentences.

We will be exploring riddles and other forms of poetry.

We will be looking at instructions linked to Fairy Tales and gain confidence in retelling a story, focussing on the beginning, middle and end.

We shall be sharing our favourite places and books to read.

We shall continue with our phonics recognising individual letters and begin to blend sounds, developing our writing for correct letter and number formation.

Numeracy

We shall be looking at the language of position and direction including ordering. We shall be counting up to 10 (and beyond) using songs and rhymes.

We will look at the language of more and less through addition and subtraction using a range of visual aids and songs.

They will also have the opportunity to solve problems in a range of real-life situations using a range of equipment.

The children will have the opportunity to make up their own problems for their peers to solve.

Creative Development

Surrounding our project of 'Let's Read' the children will be making books for our own stories.

The children will also have the opportunity to make characters from different traditional tales as well as puppets. We shall be learning about healthy breakfasts through our work in role play and DT.

We will be working with a variety of media to create Christmas pictures.

We shall be learning Christmas carols and songs for our Nativity.

Physical Development

We shall be looking at the language of position and direction to support us in a range of movements, including walking up and downstairs correctly and preparation for our Christmas Nativity.

We will move this into our PE sessions focussing on – steps, (up and down) hops and jumps using our arms for support and balance.

We shall develop our fine motor skills through craft, mark-making activities and small world play.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World.

We will be looking at families, how they can be different but all share the same love.

We shall be visiting the Library as part of our new project and going on a short autumnal walk to look at seasonal changes.

We shall be looking at operating simple equipment and technological toys.

We shall be sharing the story of Christmas and looking at the different ways Christmas is celebrated.

Personal and Social Emotional Development

We shall continue learning how to take turns and share resources and ideas when working in a small group, developing an increasing awareness of our own and others' feelings.

Children will share stories and build confidence in talking in small to large groups, providing support for the children in the lead up to Christmas when they will perform to an audience.
