

Language, Literacy and Communication

The children will be developing their communication skills through an intervention called BLAST.

The children will be exploring various stories and the way that they are structured. They will also be able to suggest how a story ends.

We will be listening to stories with more attention intending to recall with detail.

We will be able to join in with repeated phrases and anticipate the key events in stories.

The children will be able to give meaning to their mark makings as they write, paint and draw.

Physical Development

The children will build coordination to be able to balance on one leg.

We will be able use team work and concentration to catch balls of varying sizes.

The children will also be drawing lines and circles to develop fine and gross motor skills. They will also be able to use one-handed tools safely.

Personal and Social Emotional Development

The children will be building their social skills and enjoy carrying out small tasks.

Children will be working in small groups to support each other in sharing ideas and offering cues for other children to join in.

The children will be building skills to consider the needs of others; they will develop turn-taking and sharing of different resources.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World.

We will be talking about significant events and experiences we can remember.

We are going to discuss things we observe about Egypt in our class museum.

We will be using non-standardised measurements for pyramids and other artefacts related to Egypt.

They children will gain knowledge of different ways of living and will explore this at a library.

Creative Development
