

Language, Literacy and Communication

The children shall build up vocabulary to reflect on their own experiences. This will support them in grouping or naming - exploring the meaning and sounds of new words.

The children will build knowledge that print carries meaning and read from left to right top to bottom. This will move them on to understand that information can be relayed in print.

We will also be reading a range of stories and this will allow us to use narrative in our play.

Numeracy

They will move on to Counting objects to 10 and beyond 10, along with counting out objects from a larger group.

They shall count actions or objects that cannot be moved.

The children will learn to select a particular named shape. This will move on to ordering two or three items by length or height.

They shall use prepositions such as "behind" or "next to".

The children will also be introduced to language related to money. We will be exploring this in our role-play area and will be given the opportunity to buy a range of items.

Creative Development

The children will understand that tools can be used for various purposes. This will move them on to explore what happens when colours mix.

The children shall capture experiences in picture writing songs and dance.

The children will build knowledge of song and dance. They shall use movement to express feeling, ideas and experiences.

The children shall explore different sounds and how they can be changed.

Personal and Social Emotional Development

Children will learn to adapt their behaviour to different events social changes and changes in routine.

This will move them on to demonstrate friendly behaviour and forming good relationships with peers and familiar adults.

The children shall have opportunity to initiate conversation and take account of what other people say.

We will also be reflecting on our learning journey and choosing our next steps.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World.

We shall show interest in different occupations and ways of life.

The children will develop an understanding of growth, decay, and change over time.

The children shall know that information can be retrieved from a computer.

Physical Development

The children shall build confidence to jump off objects and land appropriately.

They will look for space successfully when playing racing and chasing games adjusting speed and direction to avoid obstacles.

This will move children on to increasing control in use of balancing and climbing equipment.

The children shall increase control in pushing patting throwing catching and kicking.

They shall also be planning and preparing a range of healthy foods and understanding the effect various food has on our bodies.
