

## Language, Literacy and Communication

We will develop attempts of writing short meaningful action poems. The children will be adapting work of poets as well as being able to use imagination in their writing.

Willow class will build confidence to read their writing to other children. They will have opportunity to share stories about their own family as well as hearing about our families.

We will use vocabulary and forms of speech we have seen in books. This will build their understanding that information can be retrieved from books.

We will also be looking at information text surrounding African Animals. Which we will look out for on our ship and build an information leaflet about our chosen animal.

The children will be able to respond to ideas through conversation or discussion surrounding all our opportunities to write.

## Physical Development

Willow class will understand the need of safety when we try new challenges. We will be using big movements and using benches and gymnastic tables to balance.

We will show understanding of how to move and store some of this equipment safely.

## Personal and Social Emotional Development

We shall ask appropriate questions and explain our own knowledge and understanding of the life of a pirate and why it is different to ours.

We will take steps to resolve conflict. This will develop their understanding that actions affect other people.

We will also build confidence in speaking to others about their needs, wants and opinions to adapt our work and role play when it is necessary.

## Reception Curriculum Plan Summer 2 'Pirates!'

## Knowledge and Understanding of the World.

Willow class will explore with various materials and objects used by sailors and ship crews. The children will read a compass and find treasure as well as making their own island.

We will be looking closely at similarities, differences and patterns in weather. We will also look at how to look after animals in warm weather.

We will also explore what makes us unique and talk about our families, discussing similarities and differences.

## Creative Development

We will play cooperatively in groups and act out narrative in our pirate ship and under the sea in our role play area.

We will use tools and techniques to make treasure and a map to a new island. This will allow them to explore various recyclable material.

The children will also use skills to adapt work to make it bigger or better.

## Numeracy

The children be using money to buy tickets for a sale on our pirate ship!

They shall also use more vocabulary related to subtraction and addition in these activities.

We shall order and sequence familiar events, we are going to look at our time in Willow class and event in our personal lives.

The children will record data, using marks they can interpret and explain.

We will also begin to identify mathematical problems related to traveling to a new island, time it will take to complete activities and how much money we will need.
