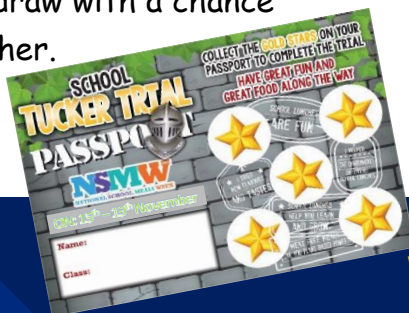
Remembrance
